Note about Medical Supplies: There are restrictions and guidelines regarding the donation of medical supplies for AHCH programs. **Please call 505-767-1178 and speak to us to discuss the possible donation** of any medical supplies, equipment, etc. that you may have. We **CANNOT** accept any hospice care equipment/supplies, medications or glucometers/test strips for diabetes care, but we may be able to provide you with a referral to another agency that would be able to accept those items.

Albuquerque Health Care for the Homeless (AHCH), a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization governed by a community-based Board of Directors, receives funding from federal, state, county, city and private sources.

Critical needs donations are essential to supporting Albuquerque Health Care for the Homeless (AHCH)'s mission to end homelessness. If you are in doubt about your donations, it is always better to call and ask.

We strive to maintain a COVID-safe campus for everyone. If you are coming to drop off donations in person we do require you to be wearing a mask.

We know you care about ensuring your donations get to the right people who need them. You might be surprised to find that Albuquerque Health Care for the Homeless cannot accept:

1. Anything that plugs in
2. Syringes
3. Medications, even if they are in their original packaging, unopened, and unexpired
4. Food*
5. Furniture
6. Large amounts of clothing – AHCH does not have the capacity to sort, clean, and store large amounts of clothing. Please note this does not include new socks and underwear, which are always needed and given out daily.
7. Hospice care equipment or supplies
8. Glucose meters or test strips

AHCH serves as a community broker for items essential to people exiting homelessness and we are always happy to refer you to the appropriate community partner organization if you have items AHCH cannot accept. Call us at 505-767-1178 if you have questions about donations.
